ACCEPTANCE POLICY

GRADES 1 THRU 10th – RETURNING STUDENTS:

Returning students whose resource fees are received by BHA prior to March 8th, 2019 will receive priority over new students for admission. Due to classroom size limitations, returning students are not guaranteed re-enrollment. If there are not enough seats to re-enroll all current students, academic and citizenship grades will be used to determine the acceptance priority. Students who seek to re-enroll and have a history of behavioral and/or academic problems may not be considered for re-enrollment.

GRADES 1 THRU 10th – NEW STUDENTS:

Before a student may enroll at BHA, parents must provide proof of immunization. Students who seek admission and have a record of suspension, expulsion, or behavior problems and/or students whose citizenship grades are below “satisfactory” may not be considered for admission.

Students applying to KG- 10th grade must pass an initial screening based on past report cards, standardized test scores, and citizenship grades before taking an Admissions Test.

Please Note: Students will be selected for admission based on their admissions test scores. Students with the highest test scores will be admitted until full capacity is reached. In case there is more than one student with the same test score, acceptance is given in order of the following criteria:

- 1) Child of BHA staff member
- 2) Child has sibling currently registered at BHA

Students who pass the initial screening and admissions test, but do not get selected once the class has reached the maximum capacity, will be placed on a waiting list. Parents will be notified if and when a seat becomes available.

Phase I: Priority applicants will be tested and may be selected for admissions based upon their test scores and availability of seats.

Phase II: Late applicants will be tested and may be selected for admissions following the end of Phase II. Admissions for late applicants will also be based upon their grades, test scores, and availability of seats.



KINDERGARTEN – NEW STUDENTS:

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT: Student must be **five years old on or before November 1st** of the current academic year in order to be considered for admission in September.

At BHA, the most fundamental criteria is readiness. Children applying to Kindergarten at BHA are screened for readiness. They will all be tested. Children showing the developmental readiness for the full-day program are offered placement in concurrence with our acceptance policy.

Please Note: Students will be selected for admission based on their admissions test scores. Students with the highest test scores will be admitted until full capacity is reached. In case there is more than one student with the same test score acceptance is given in order of the following criteria:

- 1) Child of BHA staff member
- 2) Child has sibling currently registered at BHA

Students who qualify, but are not selected once the class has reached capacity, will be placed on a waiting list pending availability. Parents will be notified once a seat becomes available.

TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN:

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT: Student must be **four years old on or before November 1st** of the current academic year in order to be considered for admission in September. Acceptance will be given priority based on the following criteria:

- 1) Child of BHA staff member
- 2) Child has sibling currently registered at BHA

Please Note: All new students are on probation for the first 30 days of school.
